



## HARVEST TIME

Harvest Time is an exciting, hands-on event held annually during October at the Beaufort Historic Site that gives 4<sup>th</sup> grade students a chance to experience life in colonial times. There are two sessions per day, each lasting about 80 minutes with four stations that students rotate between. The first session begins at 9:00 am and the second session begins at 10:30 am. We allow approximately 50 students per session so that they can be divided into small groups of 12 and have hands-on experiences at the different stations.
