*History* . . . First established in the 1960s as the Fishtown Art Gallery, the Mattie King Davis Art Gallery is the oldest gallery in the county, housed in the Rustell House c. 1732.

*Variety* . . . The Gallery contains a wide selection of mediums, subject matter, and visions. We have something for everyone's taste with oils, pastels, Chinese brushwork, pottery and handcrafted jewelry.

*Charity* . . . A portion of all sales made in the Mattie King Davis Art Gallery benefit the Beaufort Historical Association.

*Special Events* . . . There is a featured artist highlighted in the Edwin H. Vorhees room at least six times each year. Each exhibit is opened with a reception offering wine and cheese supplied by local businesses and the wonderful works of art by the featured artist of the month.

*Atmosphere* . . . The setting is tranquil and quiet under pecan trees. The interior is bright and attractive, due to natural lighting, as well as cozy, well-crafted rooms. The porch is furnished with comfortable rocking chairs that are available for visitors to sit down and relax while enjoying the day.

*Convenience* . . . The Gallery is located in central downtown Beaufort amid shops, restaurants, and the historic district. Open year round and six days out of the week, browsers are always welcome.
